1. How can you or your organization contribute to action around this strategy?

- Get screened. "Have you gotten screened?" We need to work in system.
- Patients need to know they can advocate for your health.
- Target audiences – better messaging for high-risk/low-risk.
- Create awareness in general population.
- Engage < family history screening & planning.
- Holiday & Thanksgiving conversations.

2. What opportunities do you see to advance health equity within this strategy?

- Education to targeted populations (genetics) – not cervical
- Health literacy @ younger age. Better education on anatomy & physical health. (Also support around education.)
- Assessment on how literate patients may be. Navigating patients through the system.
- Work with translators – integrity of cultural education
- Sexual health – data.
- Language HP's use: Speaking to patient in language they understand.

3. What opportunities do you see for organizations to work together (align)? What could working together look like?

- Technology systems: Not all systems use same tech. Reconcile.
- Family history – speaking to providers. If Dr. can't prove family history < we must change proof.
- Physicians – Need to pick up phone more.
- How can we take health prep & literacy outside doctor's office?
- Importance of point of contact – Primary care Dr. – work together. Denise & Flory discussed partnership.
- Standard document: Health history doc that all would accept – All systems could have seat at table.

- Community literacy – What phys. want to say? How do I communicate – Crucial to strive to come to agreement
